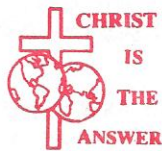
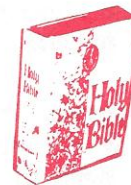

### INGREDIENTS IN LIFE

James 4:14 states, "Whereas ye know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away."

The teaching of this scripture reveals that life is short. It passes so very fast. It seems like that the older we get, the more we realize the truth of this passage. In life we are faced with so many experiences. Through these experiences, we should learn something. Yes, the lessons of life are so varied. There are some experiences that seemingly are very hard to cope with, yet, in the Lord and through them we can learn of the sufficiency of God's Wonderful Grace. There are other experiences that we face which threaten our hopes and dreams. Wise is the individual who learns something through the lessons of life. Wise is the person who doesn't give up and live in despair by accepting defeat as a norm for his or her life. This reminds me of the two frogs in the milk can. The farmer put the lid on the can, not realizing that the frogs were in the milk. One frog just gave up and died. The o-

ther frog wouldn't let his experiences or situation destroy him. He just kept kicking. The next day when the farmer opened the can he found one dead frog, but the other frog was alive and well, resting on a pad of butter. This frog made the right use of his adversity. He didn't give up.

The ingredients that make life what it is, can be summed up in 3 words. Those three words are APPROPRIATION, FORMATION, and DONATION.

#### I. APPROPRIATION.

This means to take for one's own use. In every realm of life we can see this principle at work. In the realm of Physical Development, it is seen. A person may have food placed before him, but if he does not take and eat of it, he will not develop. He will not grow. Also we could say the same thing about Intellec-



tual Development. The teacher may teach and the reader may read, but if he does not take those truths into his mind and remember them, he will not develop intellectually. This is also true as it relates to our Spiritual needs. The Availability and Accessibility of these ingredients or principles will not avail us, unless we appropriate them.

Let us notice this principle as it relates to the Spiritual Realm. In the matter of SALVATION, we must take or appropriate that Salvation which has been offered unto us. Notice this teaching in these verses.

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REV. 22:17 "And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take of the water of life freely."

PSALMS 116:13 "I will TAKE the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the Lord"

In reference to SPIRITUAL ENLIGHTENMENT, we see the same need. We must appropriate or take. Notice what the writer said in Proverbs 4:13.

"Take fast hold of instruction let her not go; keep her; for she is thy life."

This is also seen in reference to SUPPLY-Phil.4:19, STRENGTH-Phil 4:13, & Isaiah 27:5, and SPIRITUAL RENEWAL -II Chron.7:14.

The Second Ingredient is...

## II. FORMATION.

This word means to make. We need to learn to make good use of that which we have. Some people can take that which they have appropriated and greatly benefit themselves physically, materially, intellectually, and spiritually. Others, through neglect of taking and making or mis-use, spend their existence in a state of defeat, despair, and despondency. They are only existing-not really living.

On the area of the Spiritual, we need to realize that after we are saved, we have a perfect Example to follow or pattern our lives after. Better than that, we need to just let Jesus Christ take over in our lives and mold us into the person He desires us to be. We need to learn how to think the way He thought, act the way He acted and talk the way He talked. That's the true meaning of the word Christian. It means to be Christ-like. This, in essence, is the teaching of the following passages.

JOHN 13:15 "For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you."

PHIL. 3:10-14 "That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death; If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead. Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus. Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended; but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus."

ROMANS 12:1-2 "I Beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world; but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect will of God."

We need to beware of the old ideals we possessed before we were saved as noted in I Peter 1:14-15, "As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance: But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation." The Third Ingredient that is needed in life is...

## III. DONATION.

This means giving. This is one principle which is so important. To APPROPRIATE and FORMATE with a refusal to DONATE will cause us to become a stale and stagnate Christian. We will not live a vibrant life in Christ. This principle is taught in the following verses.

MATTHEW 16:25 "For whosoever will save his life shall lose it; and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it."

ACTS 20:35 "I have showed you all things, how that so laboring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, IT IS MORE BLESSED TO GIVE THAN TO RECEIVE."

I PETER 4:10 "As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God."

Remember now, that if you are going to make the most out of your life--if you want to enjoy the best life in all of these different realms you must TAKE--MAKE--and GIVE, Or APPROPRIATE--FORMATE-- and DONATE. This Cycle must constantly be repeated in our lives. This is the Good Life.

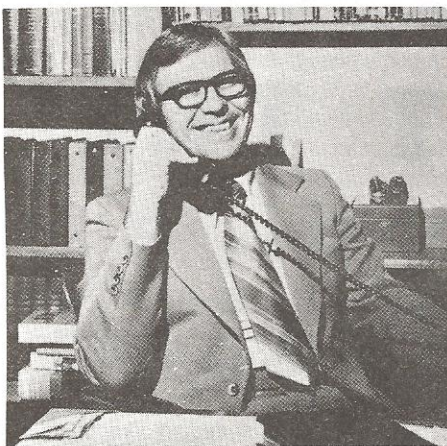

**#2 AQUARIUS

TEXT: Proverbs 3:5, 6

"Surprises are coming; plenty of them. Things are alrea-

dy popping. This period will last through the early 1980's. You'll feel the need for freedom more powerfully than ever before. You'll have fantastic highs and lows, ups and downs, sudden changes, reversals, and scores of last minute changes. Plans may be upset at the eleventh hour, but just when all is lost you'll get help from the place you least expect it. It's going to be a wild time."

This is the introduction written for the 1980 horoscopes for those born under the sign of AQUARIUS, January 21 - February 18. Millions have already purchased their printed horoscope for 1980, so that they can make their day-by-day decisions based on the "word of the stars."

In this message, I will deal briefly with the sign of the Zodiac called AQUARIUS. As the eleventh constellation in the Zodiac, AQUARIUS is symbolized by a water-bearer. The word itself means "water" or "water

pitcher." In ancient Babylon, the constellation was called GU, "the water jar." To the Akkadians, it was KU UR KU, "the seat of the flowing waters." The Hebrews, Syrians, Persians, Turks and Hindus all regarded it as a "water bucket." Years later, the Greeks added the figure of a man and identified the constellation with the mythical figure GANYMEDE, the "cup-bearer of the gods." Finally, the Egyptians equated it with KHUM, the "god of the life-giving water."

To those born under this "sign," their lives are to be highly influenced by this "water-bearer." For them, it is to be a time of peace, friendship, brotherhood, and sisterhood. They are referred to as "pouring the water of life and intelligence for humanity to drink."

Christianity points to another "water-bearer" who influences and changes the lives of men, the Lord Jesus Christ.

The Bible refers to Him as the Bearer of Living Water, John 4 verse 10. The water He bears is referred to as a "well of water springing up into everlasting life." John 4:14. Christ is also the Giver of the "living waters," which is a reference to the Holy Spirit, John 7:37-39. At the close of the Bible's message, Christ is seen offering Himself to all who are thirsty, to take "the water of life freely," Revelation 22:17.

The constellation of AQUARIUS contains several brilliant stars which are believed to bring "good luck" to those born under this sign. The brightest star, a double star, SADALMALIK (Arabic), means "the good luck of the king." The second brightest star, SADALSUUD (Fortuna Fortunatum), means "the fortune of good luck." The third brightest star, SADACHBIA, is supposed to be "the good luck of the tent."

The "brightest star" in the Christian's life is his Saviour, the "bright and morning

star." Revelation 22:16. It is upon Him, not good luck, that the Christian depends for the welfare of his life. Christians believe that the events of their lives are determined by the purpose and will of God, not on good luck, Ephesians 1 verse 5; James 1:18.

Those born from January 21 to February 18, are said to have certain personality characteristics and attributes because they were born under the sign of AQUARIUS. For example, AQUARIUS is in the "house of friendship," so friendship and goodwill are said to be Aquarian attributes. Other attributes include "brotherly love and respect for the rights of all men and women on earth."

In Christianity, the high qualities of a saved person are not due to the sign he is born under, but to the working of the Holy Spirit in his life, such Spirit producing fruit (Galatians 5:22, 23). It is the Spirit of God that produces the qualities of love, meekness, joy, etc., not the influence of the stars.

Aquarians are also said to be group conscious, but are seldom a part of the herd. They are shepherds who help others reach their aspirations. But to the Christian, Jesus Christ is the Good Shepherd, who leads them as tenderly and wisely as an earthly shepherd would his flock of sheep.

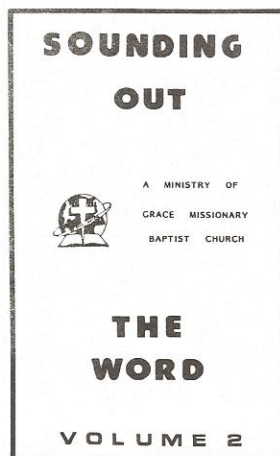
Water-bearer, friend, shepherd. All of these terms are connected with the sign AQUARIUS. By them, many will determine which direction they will take, and what kind of people they will try to be. Some may succeed; some may fail. It is really a "chancy" business, based on "luck."

In the Christian's Saviour, all attributes are summed up in Psalms 23:1, 2, "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters." Jesus is our Water-bearer, our Friend, and our Shepherd. We need not have to turn to the predictions of the Aquarian horoscope. Christ is all we need.

## I. SOME THINGS IMPLIED BY THIS STATEMENT.

    1. Attending church by itself does not save a soul. Luke 18- the story of the Pharisee and Publican.
    2. But it is a mighty fine place to find the Saviour.
      - a. Because the gospel is preached.
      - b. Because it is a house of prayer.
      - c. Because of the Lord's promised presence.
      - d. Because of the convicting power of the Spirit and can you even imagine how a truly saved person would not want to go to church? Psa. 122:1

## II. SOME THINGS SUGGESTED BY THESE THOUGHTS.
